Please pick up your offering envelopes in the front of the church or the hallway behind the sanctuary. Join with the body of Northside as we pay off our debt in 2015.



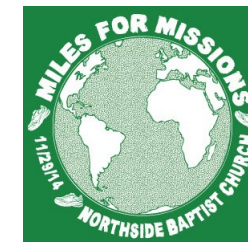
