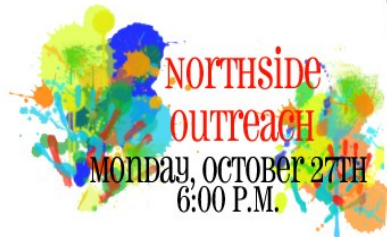

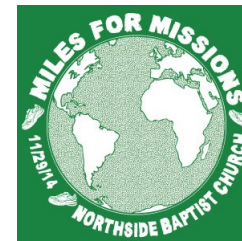
AWANA GRAND PRIX
